

# Final conference of the international research project *Enacting Citizenship and Solidarity in Europe* "From Below": Local Initiatives, Intersectional Strategies, and Transnational Networks [ECSEuro]

In the last two decades, the multiplication of crises has increased the challenges for European society. While the nation-states dominating the European project have hardly been able to find adequate responses to the turmoil, new forms of practicing solidarity and citizenship have been growing at the local level. They emerge in opposition to the established politics imposed ,from above' by the world order of nation-states, capitalism and the public-private split, and they create alternative forms of political engagement, collaboration and societal organization ,from below'. Starting from the

assumption that only research addressing the local scale and its multi-scalar entanglements can provide adequate responses to current challenges, we assemble speakers to present their work on urban civil society and social movement organizations.
